Theory & Practical:

Fire is an exothermic chemical process which may lead to huge loss in lives, property, material and environment if effective and preventative methods are not undertaken. The Factories Act, 1948, as amended by the Factories (Amendment) Act, 1987 states that all practicable measures shall be taken to prevent the outbreak of fire and its spread, both internally, externally to provide and maintain safe means of escape for all persons in the event of fire and the necessary equipment and facilities for extinguishing fire.
